Paternal family members:

Maternal family members:

Relatives from mother side are called maternal family members.



Grandfather (Nana)	Grandmother (Nani)	Uncle (Mamu)	Aunt (Khala)
Mother's father	Mother's mother	Mother's brother	Mother's sister

Joint family: In some families grandfather, grandmother, father, mother, uncle, aunt and their children live together in same house. Such type of family is called joint family.



Cousins:

Children of our uncle and aunt are called our cousins. They may be from:

- Paternal side (father).
- Maternal side (mother).

We talk to each other.
