



**Worship:**

Worship means praying. People of different religions go to different places to worship as they have different beliefs.

- Christians go to churches
- Hindus go to temples.





### Place of Worship for Muslims:

#### Masjid:

- Masjid is a place where Muslims go to pray.
- They pray together in rows, facing towards the Kaaba.
- Masjid is a peaceful place where people feel close to Allah.
- Muslims go to the Masjid to pray five times a day, at dawn (Fajr), midday (Dhuhr), afternoon (Asr), sunset (Maghrib), and evening (Isha).
- The holy Book of Muslims is Quran.



#### Place of Worship for Non-Muslims

For non-Muslims, places of worship include churches, temples, gurdwara and other sacred spaces where people gather to pray and practice their religions.

- Inquire about other places of worship (church, temple, gurdwara etc.)



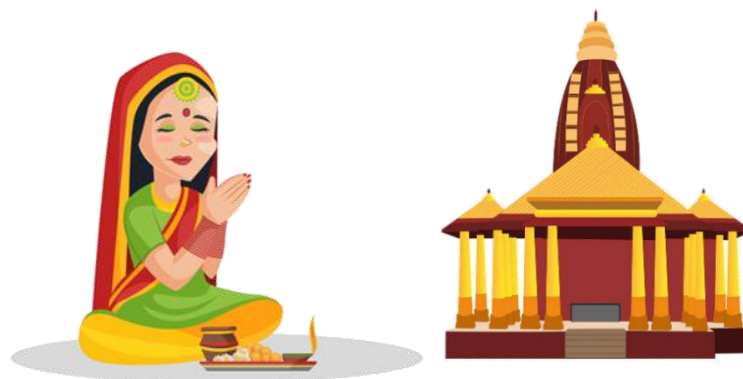
**Church:**

- A church is a special place where Christians go to pray, sing songs, and learn about their religion.
- They listen stories from their holy book called the Bible.



**Temple:**

- A temple is a special place where people who follow religions like Hinduism, Buddhism, or others go to pray and learn about their beliefs.
- Their holy books are Bhagvad Gita and the Vedas.





**Gurdwara:**

- A gurdwara is a special place where Sikhs go to pray and learn about their faith.
- It is a place where everyone is welcomed and served free meals, called langar.
- Their holy book is Guru Granth Sahib.



**Respect for All Religions:**

We should respect all religions to make a better and peaceful society.

- People believe in different ways, and it is important to be friendly to everyone, no matter what they believe.
- Being kind to everyone, no matter their beliefs, makes everyone feel happy and safe.
- When we respect each other's religions, we show that we care about each other's feelings and thoughts.
- This helps us all be friends with people who are different from us.
