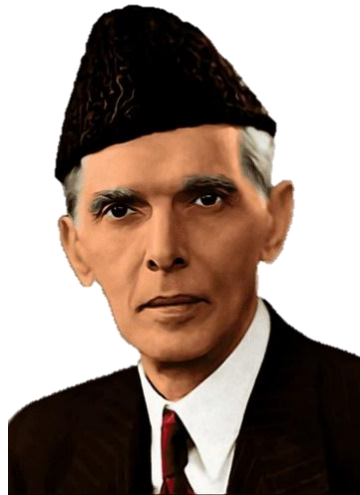




**Quaid-e-Azam:**

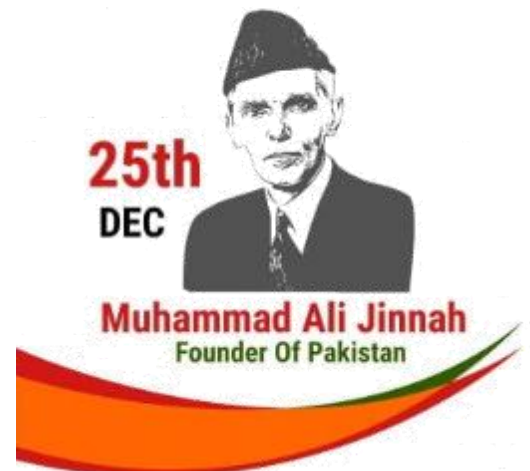

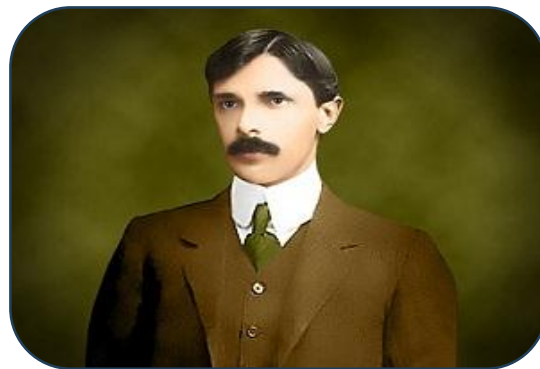


**Studies:**

Jinnah was the leader of a group called the Muslim League. He worked hard to get a separate country for Muslims.



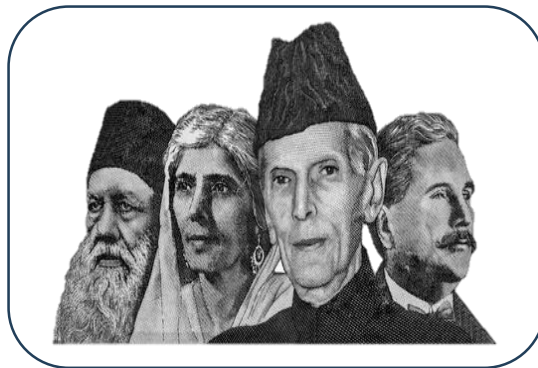
- **Pakistan Movement:**
