Students' Learning Outcomes

Recognize that all human beings are equal and important.



Diversity of human beings:

Diversity means "*variety*". Huge variety of human beings live on planet Earth.

- ❖ Some people are Muslims.
- ❖ Some people are Christians.
- ❖ Some people are Hindu.

"Apart from their religion, they are all human beings, though they have different families, cultures, languages, and beliefs.

We have same needs. We play together. We all eat food. We all wear clothes. We live in houses. We might have different culture, but our basic needs are same.

Students' Learning Outcomes

Identify that all human beings are similar but differ by family, culture, ethnicity, religion and should be respected.





Respect for all:

Whether someone is white or black; rich or poor, he/she is equally important for us. He/she has equal rights. We should respect:

- ❖ Our elders.
- ❖ Our friends.
- ❖ Our neighbours.
- ❖ Our relatives.
- ❖ Our teachers.

We should not use bad words for anyone. We should help the needy persons. Men and women should be respected equally.

Wait for your turn:

We need to follow some rules to live together. Waiting for your turn is one of them. Because it creates discipline and equality for all. Nobody is superior or inferior.

Waiting for our turn patiently helps everyone to take their turn and makes things fair for everyone.

Students' Learning Outcomes

Recognize the need to respect all people as they can show respect for all.



Students' Learning Outcomes

Identify occasions when it is important to wait for one's turn for example while speaking, in the school, the bus stop at the canteen and ticketing counters etc.

Students' Learning Outcomes

- Giving respect by offering a seat.
