Rights of the citizens:

Government provides rights to its public. Such as:

***** Right to food:

Every person has a right to eat healthy food and

drink clean water. Government should provide these things to its citizens.

- Right to Education: This guarantees every citizen the right to free education up to a certain age.
- Right to Healthcare: This ensures that citizens have access to medical facilities promoting their right to live a healthy life.
