Key problems of a community:

While living in a community we face different problem in a community. These problem make life difficult. Human cannot live a normal life because of these problems.

Shortage of Drinking Water: Sometimes, there is not enough clean water for everyone to drink. This can make it hard for people to stay healthy and do everyday tasks.

Pollution: Pollution occurs when things like trash, smoke, or chemicals make the air, water, or land dirty. This can be bad for people's health and the environment.

Lack of Health Facilities: If there are not enough hospitals or clinics, it can be hard for people to get the medical help they need when they are sick or injured.

Lack of Educational Facilities: Without enough schools, children might not get the education they need to learn new things and succeed.

Poor Sewage System: If the sewage system does not work well, it can cause problems like dirty water and bad smells, which can make people sick.

These problems can affect everyone in the community, so it is important to find ways to fix them and make the area a better place to live.

Government:


Government is a group of people who work together for the betterment of a country and its people.
