Traffic Signals:

Traffic signals are colored lights that tell us when to stop and when to go on the road. These lights keep us safe from accidents.





Colours of lights:

The traffic lights are of three different colours.

- Red Light
- Green light
- Yellow light

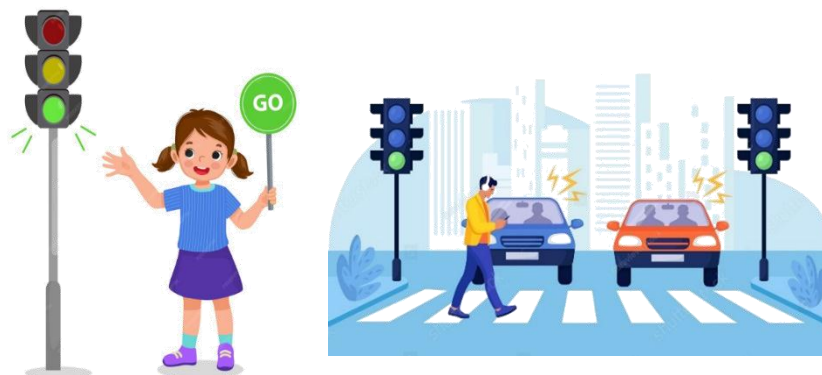
Red Light:

When the light is red, it means "stop."



Green Light:

When the light turns green, it means "go."





Yellow Light:

The yellow light means "slow down" or "get ready to stop."



Safety Rules:

Safety rules for traffic are important because they help keep us safe and prevent accidents.

Safety Rules for Walking:

- We should follow certain rules while walking on the road.

<p>Always walk on the sidewalk</p>	<p>Hold an adult's hand when walking on the road.</p>	<p>Stay alert and avoid distractions while walking.</p>



Safety Rules for Crossing Road:

- We should follow certain rules while crossing the road.

<p>Wait for the green "walk" sign to cross the road.</p>	<p>Make sure cars have stopped before you cross.</p>	<p>Look both ways before crossing any driveway or street.</p>

Safety Rules for Travelling on a Bus:

- We should follow certain rules while travelling on a bus.

<p>Wait for the bus to stop completely before getting on.</p>	<p>Keep your hands and head inside the bus.</p>	<p>Fasten your seat belt to avoid injuries in case of an accident..</p>
