Transportation means how people and things move from one place to another.



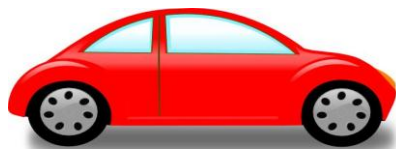

People use different things to move from one place to another. The different means of transportation are:



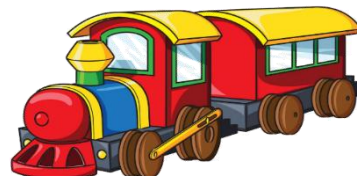
car

Ports and Stations:

Bus Stop:

- A bus stop is the place where buses stop.
- At bus stops people wait for buses to take them to different places.

Railway Station:

- A railway station is a place where trains stop.
- At railway stations trains arrive to pick up and drop off passengers.



**Airport:**

- An airport is the place where aeroplanes land.
- On Airports, airplanes take off and land, for people to travel far away.

**Harbour:**

- Harbour is a place where ships birth.
- Here boats and ships stop to let people get on or off.
