Transportation means how people and things move from one place to another.





Slow means of transportation move slowly.


### **Examples:**

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


# **Fast Means of Transportation:**

### **Bus Stop:**

- A bus stop is the place where buses stop.
- At bus stops people wait for buses to take them to different places.
