Activities:

- To brain storm the students, take an egg or egg picture in the classroom ask some question about it
 - What is it?
 - Have you ever eaten an egg?
 - Which animal has a trunk?

Development

Model Reading & Methodology:

- Tell the students that we are going to learn English alphabet.
- Explain them that we are going to read the fifth letter “e”.
- Show them the flash cards of the letter “e” and introduce its sound “ee”.

- Explain them the initial sound in the name of 'egg' is / e /.
- Show them a 'egg' flash card and instruct the children to say the name of the picture, i.e.
- Instruct the children to look carefully at the pages of 'e' on the textbook. Then turn your finger on 'e' five to seven times.
