Activities:

- To brain storm the students, take a glass in the classroom ask some question about it
 - What is it?
 - What do we use glass for?

Development

Model Reading & Methodology:

- Tell the students that we are going to learn English alphabet.
- Explain them that we are going to read the seventh letter “g”.

- Show them the flash cards of the letter “g” and introduce its sound “jee”.
- Explain them the initial sound in the name of ‘grapes’ is / g /.
- Show them a ‘grapes’ flash card and instruct the children to say the name of the picture, i.e. ‘grapes’ and emphasize the first sound / g /.
- Instruct the children to look carefully at the pages of ‘g’ on the textbook. Then turn your finger on ‘g’ five to seven times.
